Special Guest Speaker Jeremy Feldbusch will be in attendance. Jeremy is a U.S. Army Ranger who is now a member and spokesman of the Wounded Warrior Project. During a firefight for key terrain in Iraq, Jeremy manned a mortar for 36 hours under heavy enemy fire, destroying a missile defense system and repelling enemy soldiers. During this intense Combat Action, Jeremy was seriously wounded by enemy fire.
