

Pennsylvania, Army Reserve Memorial, Greensburg, PA., February 25, 2011

The PGR has been invited to stand in remembering with honors and respect of the 13 KIA's and 45 WIA's of the 14th Quartermaster Detachment, PA Army Reserve, Greensburg, PA in a ceremony that will take place on February 25th 2011 at 12:00 PM (noon) until 12:28 PM.

At 8:40 pm (12:40 pm EST) on February 25, 1991, parts of an Iraqi SCUD missile destroyed the barracks housing members of the 14th Quartermaster Detachment. In the single, most devastating attack on U.S. forces during that war, 29 soldiers died and 99 were wounded. The 14th Quartermaster Detachment lost 13 soldiers and suffered 45 wounded.

Staging will be at Hoss's Steak House located at routes 30 and 119 (Greensburg, PA.) at 9:00 AM on Friday, 25 Feb 2011.

Ride brief at 9:05 AM and depart as a group at 9:20 AM and travel up the hill to the Armory (about 1 mile), 900 Armory Drive, Greensburg, PA. 15601 and park in our (PGR) designated parking area. (If you arrive at a later time, we have secured additional/overflow parking at the Greensburg Catholic Central School which is across the street from the Armory. Parking will be in the right rear of the building in a gravel lot next to the football field.)
