PURPLE HEART "FOREVER STAMP" UNVEILING IN SAN DIEGO, CA

Patriots. The ceremony for the unveiling of the "[Purple Heart Forever Stamp](#)" will take place in San Diego, CA, beginning on the 4th of May 2011. The ceremonial unveiling by the Post Master General will be at the San Diego Convention Center. [A time has not been released]

Then, on May 5, 2011 at 11:00 a.m. on the U.S.S. Midway Museum, moored at the Foot-of-Broadway, will host the official unveiling to the public. The celebration will be a dedication of the [Purple Heart Forever Stamp](#) and it will also be the first day of Issuance.

The Military Order of the Purple Heart (MOPH) has lobbied Congress and the U.S. Post Office for over 2 years to get the [Purple Heart Forever Stamp](#) authorized and issued. Now we have achieve a degree of success.
